HOMEWORK POLICY




- Homework is provided to reinforce or extend curriculum skills. In addition, the purpose of homework is to help students become **RESPONSIBLE** and **INDEPENDENT** learners.
- Homework may include: word study, math facts, problem solving practice, reading logs, writing and prep for projects and tests.
- Projects may require work at home and will usually take one to two weeks to complete.
- Since projects are given with advance notice of due dates, absences are not an excuse for turning in projects late.
- ALL homework assignments and projects are recorded DAILY by your child in the agenda.
 - o If your child's agenda is empty . . . be very suspicious. Even days when there is no homework, students should write, "No Homework".
- Unfinished, missing or late homework will result in loss of a paw and could possibly result in a change of personal development grade. (No exceptions from parents bringing work to school).
- Unfinished, missing or late homework will be completed during FLEX Friday. If homework is completed before, they will lose the paw, but not the extra recess time.
- <u>Homework must be completed **at home**</u>. If homework completion becomes a problem for your child, schedule an appointment with your teachers to discuss possible options.

CLASS WORK POLICY



- <u>Unfinished class work must be completed **at school** unless special permission has been given from the teacher.</u>
- Late work is reflected on the report card in the area of personal development.
- Students who complete overdue assignments before FLEX Friday will have the choice of losing 10 points off the assignment or 10 minutes off extra recess.
- Assignments not completed by the determined due date will be entered into the grade book as a failing grade. Due dates will be recorded on the assignment and/or agenda.

MAKE UP WORK POLICY



- If a student is absent, the student has 3 days to make up any missing work.
- One additional day will be granted for every day after the first absence. *i.e.*: Raven is absent on Monday. Make up assignments (homework and class work) are due Friday morning.

Day 1, Tuesday, Day 2, Wednesday, Day 3, Thursday). Raven is absent on Monday and Tuesday. She has until Monday, the following week to turn assignments in.

- Weekends will count as make up days. i.e.: Raven is absent Thursday. She has Friday, Saturday, and Sunday to make up the work. Assignments would be due first thing Monday morning.
- Failure to turn in assignments on time will result in a failing grade in the grade book.
